



SELECTION CRITERIA

The International Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (IWWF) will announce the athlete selection list latest 15th July 2019

Wakeboard

(12 Men & 12 Women)

- maximum 2 athletes per country per medal discipline

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

1. Athletes selected from countries with the best overall team results at the 2017 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships
2. Current IWWF World, IWWF Confederation and National Champions will have preference over other athletes;
3. Mandatory participation at the last IWWF World Wakeboard Championships in Argentina (exceptions for injured athletes with a medical certificate – must have participated at the previous IWWF World Wakeboard Championships in Mexico);
** athletes must also have participated at their most recent Confederation Championships or at their respective National Championships*
5. As Wild Cards – 2 x wild cards available (Male & Female) for the host country;
6. As Wild Cards – 2 x available (Male & Female) for the International Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (IWWF)
7. *Each NOC will be notified of their athlete's selection. In the event, an NOC's selected athlete is unable to participate or is forced to withdraw, the next NOC from the list will be selected*

Waterski Jump

(12 men & 12 women)

The selection mandate is to have the best athletes from the most countries, with maximum one athlete per country by gender except for the top 4 on the World Rankings list.

1. The top 4 ranked men/women are automatically selected and then the next 8 athletes are selected using the last approved World Rankings List. The top athletes wouldn't be considered in the one per country restriction but their countries would be considered selected (example: if the top 4 athletes were FRA, USA, CAN, FRA then FRA, CAN and USA skiers have been selected but there would be 2 FRA skiers allowed).
2. Once the top 10 are selected, the 11th and 12th would either be the next athlete on the list or a substitute to provide Confederation representation.
3. If athletes decline to participate, a substitution is required. The method used is:
 - a. If an athlete declines then he/she can be replaced by an athlete from the same country as long as that athlete is rated higher than the lowest ranked athlete in the event, with the exception that the lowest ranked athlete does not include athletes selected as substitutes for Confederation representation.
 - b. If that is not the case, then the next athlete on the original list is selected.
